QUALIFICATIONS FOR SPECIAL DISTRICT DIRECTORS: Any person who is a qualified registered voter, residing within the district boundaries, and qualified by the Constitution or laws of the State to hold a civil office is eligible.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that official declarations of candidacy for eligible candidates desiring to file for any of the above elective offices may be obtained from the office of the County Clerk/Registrar of Voters located in the Annex behind the Historical Courthouse at 220 South Lassen St., Suite 5, Susanville, CA 96130, on or after July 13, 2026, and must be filed not later than 5:00 p.m. on August 7, 2026; provided, if declarations of candidacy for an incumbent are not filed by the latter date and hour, eligible candidates, other than the incumbent for such office, shall have until 5:00 p.m. on August 12, 2026, to file declarations of candidacy.

Appointments to each elective office will be made by the supervising authority as prescribed in Section 10515, California Elections Code, in the event there are no candidates, or an insufficient number of candidates for such office and a petition for an election is not filed with the elections official within the time period prescribed by Section 10515 Elections Code, that is by 5:00 p.m. on August 12, 2026.
