ALL WATER CUSTOMERS:

As our drought worsens, we are asking all residents to voluntarily reduce water use by 20%. Various water districts have initiated various restrictions; our policy, at this point, is a 20% reduction in usage and a 100% increase in common sense. Avoid waste and runoff.

All customers are encouraged to limit their outdoor use of potable water by:

1. Limiting outdoor irrigation to the hours between 12:00 a.m. (midnight) and 9:00 a.m. **and** 6:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m. to maximize greater soil adsorption while reducing the potential of evaporation: and
2. Limit the number of outdoor watering days to three per week. • Even numbered addresses may water outside on Tuesdays, Thursday and Saturday. Odd numbered addresses may water outside on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday
3. Watering a personal food garden is exempt.
4. No use of potable water to driveways and sidewalks.
5. Washing vehicle with a bucket or a hose with a shut-off nozzle
6. The use of potable water to outdoor landscapes in a manner that causes runoff such that water flows onto an adjacent property, non-irrigated areas, private and public roadways, parking lots, or structures.

Check for and fix leaks.
